

GET STARTED WITH THE LIBBY APP

The Libby app is an easy way for Williamson County Public Library members to read or listen to digital books and audiobooks.

Step 1

Install the Libby app from your device's app store: **Apple App Store / Google Play / Windows Store**

*To download the Libby app on a **Kindle Fire** device, you must follow the instructions at this link prior to performing the steps listed below: <https://www.overdrive.com/apps/libby/kindlefire>*

Step 2

Open the Libby app. On the Welcome screen, you'll be asked if you have a library card. Click **Yes**. Then click **I'll Search for a Library**. In the next screen, type zip code **37064** in the search box. Click on the box that says **Tennessee READS Buffalo River Region – Williamson County Public Library**.

Step 3

You'll be prompted to sign into your Tennessee READS account. Click on **Choose a Location**. In the list of libraries that appears, scroll down to the name of your library (either Williamson County Public Library or one of our branches). Enter your library card number with no spaces and click **Next**. You'll be asked for your Pin number. It should be the last 4 digits of your library card number unless you have recently changed it. Click **Sign In**. An image of a library card with your card number will appear. Click **Next**.

Step 4

On the next screen you'll be given the option to always send eBooks to your Kindle eReader, such as a Paperwhite. If that is your preference, click **Yes, I Read With Kindle**. If you'll be reading or listening on your smart phone or tablet, click **Skip**.

Step 5

At the bottom of the screen, you will see several icons.

- Choose the **Search** icon to search for and borrow books: 
- Choose the **Shelf** icon to access books you have borrowed: 

Step 6

After clicking the **Search** icon, search for a specific title or author. You can also browse through the collection by clicking **EXPLORE WITH FILTERS** to see different categories of books.

Step 7

To borrow a book, tap **Borrow**. The next screen gives you the option to select a borrowing period. Choose either 7 days, 14 days or 21 days. Tap the loan period you prefer and then tap **Borrow** again. If the book is currently checked out to someone else, you can click **Place a Hold**.

Step 8

Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download to the app automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

- On your Shelf, tap **Open Book** or **Open Audiobook** to start reading or listening to a title.
